Central Meeting Report-Mr. Fuller

Mr. Fuller reviewed the board summary from Central's September board meeting.

PURPA 111 (d) Written Determination Requirement-Mr. Fuller

Mr. Fuller discussed that PURPA 111 (d) written determination would have to be approved by

November 15th. A resolution will need to be signed at the October board meeting.

**ECSC Report- Mr. Sanders** 

Mr. Sanders stated that the projected 2024 ECSC Dues would be \$1,086,542 (increased to

\$50,906) amount to be billed per month would be \$90,545.17. Mr. Sanders also discussed their

two-year ECSC budget comparison and their projected 2024 income statement.

Audit Report-Mr. Vandross

Mr. Vandross stated that the audit committee meet and approved expense reports and executive

staff's credit card statements and there were no discrepancies.

Financial Reports- Mr. Stevens

Mr. Stevens reviewed the financial reports from July 2023. Mr. Stevens reviewed portions of the

statement of operations and the balance on Form 7.

Wage and Salary 2023-2024 Proposal-Mr. Stevens

Mr. Stevens gave a brief overview of what inflation (CPI) 3.6% and that the average pay is at

90% of market which is below market minimum. Mr. Stevens proposed three different raise

package options. The recommendation was made to make a market adjustment for the line

workers that would total \$280,000. Also, a \$500.00 Christmas bonus per employee that would be

paid out to employees in November 2023. No action was taken.

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Coastal Security Alarm Program-Mr. Vincent and Mrs. Langdon

Mr. Vincent recommended that we cancel the partnership with Coastal Security Alarm. After a

thoroughly discussion upon a motion by Mr. Chavis, seconded by Mr. Clayton and unanimously

passed: it was

RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees hereby approves that we will stop the partnership

with Coastal Security Alarm.
